

# Architect Photo Checklist

Architectural documentation spans the full project lifecycle — from existing conditions and design development through construction administration and project closeout. When a client disputes design intent, a contractor deviates from plans, or a liability issue arises, the question is always the same: **can you prove what existing conditions were, that the work conformed to the approved documents, and that deviations were caught and addressed?** This guide gives your team the exact shots to capture on every project.

## THE 7 PHASES

### Document Every Phase, Protect Every Job

#### 01 PHASE Existing Conditions Survey

- Exterior — all four elevations
- All interior spaces — four-wall shots
- Structural elements — beams & columns
- Mechanical, electrical & plumbing systems
- Window & door conditions & sizes
- Floor, wall & ceiling finishes
- Roof condition & drainage
- Site — topography & utilities
- Neighboring structures & setbacks

#### 02 PHASE Pre-Construction & Permit Set

- Approved permit set on-site confirmed
- Stamped drawings — all sheets visible
- Permit card posted at job site
- Pre-construction meeting documented
- Site mobilization conditions
- Existing conditions at start of work
- Contractor staging areas noted
- Protection of existing elements
- Utility locations confirmed

#### 03 PHASE Foundations & Structural

- Footing & foundation per structural plan
- Rebar placement matches drawings
- Anchor bolt layout per plan
- Structural steel connections
- Beam & column sizes confirmed
- Shear wall layout & nailing per plan
- Structural deviations noted & photographed
- Structural engineer site observation
- Foundation inspection approval



## 04 PHASE Construction Administration — Rough

- Framing per approved drawings
- Opening sizes match plan dimensions
- MEP rough-in locations per drawings
- Deviations from approved plans noted
- RFI responses implemented & confirmed
- Submittal approvals on-site
- Framing inspection card
- MEP inspection card
- Wide shot — all rough work in progress

## 05 PHASE Construction Administration — Finishes

- Exterior envelope per specifications
- Window & door installation per details
- Interior finishes per finish schedule
- Millwork & cabinetry per drawings
- Tile & flooring per finish plan
- Paint colors per approved palette
- Light fixtures per electrical plan
- Hardware per finish schedule
- All finishes — wide shots per room

## 06 PHASE Punch List & Substantial Completion

- Punch list items — before & after
- Deficiencies noted with location reference
- Corrections confirmed complete
- Finish quality — close-up detail shots
- All systems tested & operational
- Certificate of substantial completion
- Final inspections — all approvals
- Owner walkthrough documented
- Attic & crawlspace final condition

## 07 PHASE Project Closeout Documentation

- Certificate of occupancy obtained
- Final exterior — all four elevations
- Final interior — all rooms complete
- As-built conditions vs. drawings noted
- Mechanical systems — final conditions
- Warranty documentation photographed
- O&M manuals delivered & photographed
- Keys & access devices transferred
- Final project — wide shot all areas

## HOW TO USE THIS IN THE FIELD

# Turn This Checklist Into Your Daily Workflow

- 01 Document Existing Conditions Before Demolition Begins**  
Existing conditions photos are your baseline for every change-order negotiation and every liability dispute. Take more than you think you need — from every angle — before a single wall comes down or a floor is disturbed.
- 02 Photograph Every Deviation from the Approved Documents**  
When a contractor builds something differently than drawn, photograph it immediately with the approved drawing visible in the same frame if possible. This creates a clear record of what was observed, when, and what corrective direction was given.
- 03 Capture Construction Administration Observations Systematically**  
Date-stamped, location-tagged photos taken at every site visit create the paper trail that supports your CA role. Without them, your field reports are assertions — with them, they become evidence.
- 04 Before-and-After on Every Punch List Item**  
A photo of each deficiency when identified and a follow-up photo after correction creates an irrefutable record that the punch list was closed — protecting you from disputes about incomplete work at project closeout.

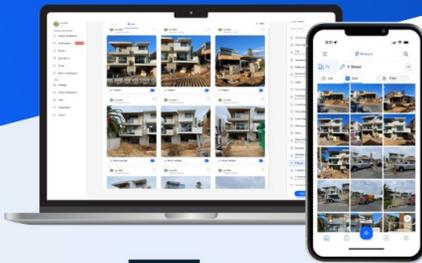
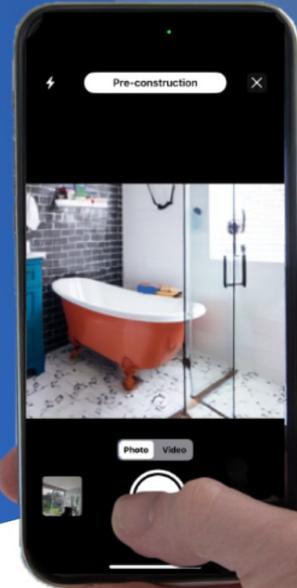
